It includes three main user interfaces: a Public Portal for general route and boundary lookups, a Parent Portal for individual student transportation details and notifications, and a Professional Portal for school and transportation staff to view and manage routing data. The application is designed to reduce administrative workload by enabling self-service access to schedules, maps, delays, and updates through a configurable, role-based interface.
